Course Description: This course provides in-depth exploration of current issues in social psychology. It builds on core concepts and theories to delve into specific areas of research, practice and critical analysis in the field. The complex interplay of individual and social factors in shaping behavior, cognition, and emotions will be addressed. This course will introduce the theories and research that explain our social world. Social thinking (e.g., social identity, judgments, and attitudes), social influence (e.g., culture, conformity, obedience, and persuasion), and social relationships (e.g., prejudice, aggression, attraction) to learn how individuals' thoughts, feelings, and actions influence and are affected by those of others, helping and conflict resolution) will be examined. with criminals and judicial processes will be examined.
