TOPIC: "The Role of Social and Psychological Factors in the Development and Maintenance of Addiction"

SCOPE: This assignment includes a literature review aimed at understanding the role of social and psychological factors in the development and maintenance of addiction. Discuss how social and psychological factors contribute to the development and maintenance of addictive behaviors. In your papers, include:

- a. a comparison of at least two psychological theories (e.g., Behavioral, Cognitive-Behavioral, or Psychoanalytic) and their application to addiction.
- b. the influence of environmental and social factors, such as peer pressure, cultural norms, or socioeconomic status.
- c. possible interventions or prevention strategies targeting these factors.

Support your argument with research findings, real-world examples, and critical analysis of the theories.

MATERIALS: This assignment should include at least 10 journal articles.

MECHANICS: The sources for this assignment should have proper in-text and reference citations due to APA 7th version.

WORD COUNT: 2500-3000 words (excluding bibliography). Please write the Word count at the bottom of your last page.
